ANTELOPE VALLEY RIDERS

On Saturday, April 10, the Antelope Valley Riders, a motorcycle club chartered with the SCMA, held their annual poker run to benefit a local charity. The club selected Bags4Kids (www.Bags4Kids.org) once again as the poker run beneficiary. Bags4Kids is an Antelope Valley charity that provides backpacks with necessities and comfort items for kids displaced by circumstances beyond their control.

Although attendance was low, only 42 registered riders, the poker run managed to raise nearly \$1500 for the charity. The poker run started and ended at Antelope Valley Harley Davidson in Lancaster and included many raffle prizes (such as motorcycle helmets, gift certificates, and other items donated by local businesses), 50-50 drawing, t-shirts for all entrants, a complete lunch, and entertainment by two local bands, Kingpin and Blue Mountain Tribe, all for \$25 or less depending on discounts.

The SCMA affiliation helped bring in about half of the riders, mostly Traveler's Award participants. The SCMA sanctions or sponsors about one ride a month throughout Southern California. SCMA members have come to expect that if the ride is on the SCMA calendar, then it will be well organized, not cost an arm and a leg, and the ride will be an interesting one. The AVR Poker Run was about 110 miles on all kinds of roads and included roads through town, winding mountain roads, a musical road (Lancaster's Musical Road), driving by the blooming California Poppies, a checkpoint at Palmdale's Joe Davies Heritage Air Park with two dozen airplanes on display (including an A-7 Corsair adopted by the AVR), all on a near perfect spring day. The AVR members who created the route were unable to take credit for the beautiful day. They had little to do with the weather.

AVR members wish to thank the SCMA for their continuing support, this year as well as previous years. AVR appreciates everything that is done by the SCMA as well as their affiliated clubs.

BLAZING SADDLES RIDE

The Road Beckons: Blazing Saddles May 29-30 (and the 31st)

The weather is warming. The Southern California Motorcycling Association is waking from its winter semi-hiatus and its time to do some serious riding. John "Blazing Saddles" Katics has created a two-day (really a three-day) adventure that will put miles under your butt, a smile on your face, and an opportunity to find your old friends and make new friends.

2010 Blazing Saddles will start early Saturday morning in Bakersfield at Zingo's Café on Buck Owens Blvd. just off Highway 99. Zingo's is one of those terrific old cafes with dishwasher coffee, thick bacon, farm-fresh eggs, plate-sized pancakes and a great reputation. It's one of those highway cafes where bikers, car buffs, truckers and COFs like us find real food, a real jukebox and real friends.

We'll head north and west up and over the southern flanks of the Sierras and then north up US 395 along the eastern slope. At that time of the morning, the views of the mountains will be spectacular.

We'll leave 395 at Big Pine and climb over the White Mountains, heading up past the 2000 year old Bristle Cone Pines—the oldest living things on the earth. We will then travel the Lonely Road: US 6 in Nevada. With the afternoon sun at our backs, we'll see Nevada as it is meant to be seen in the spring—still green and filled with endless horizons of mountains and sloping valleys.

We'll overnight in Ely where we will collect for dinner and libations. Cigars may be in order before turning in for the night at Motel 6 where we have a smokin' deal—pun intended.

Sunday we will leave Ely stopping for passport stamps along the way on US 50 so we can get certificates and memorial pins marking our survival. We will overnight in Carson City at the Motel 6 there.

Monday is still in the planning stage, because we aren't quite sure where we will cross over the Sierras to the west side. The heavy snow pack may mean the best passes won't be opened by the time we ride. We'll announce more when we know more. See the May newsletter for the Motel 6 contact numbers.

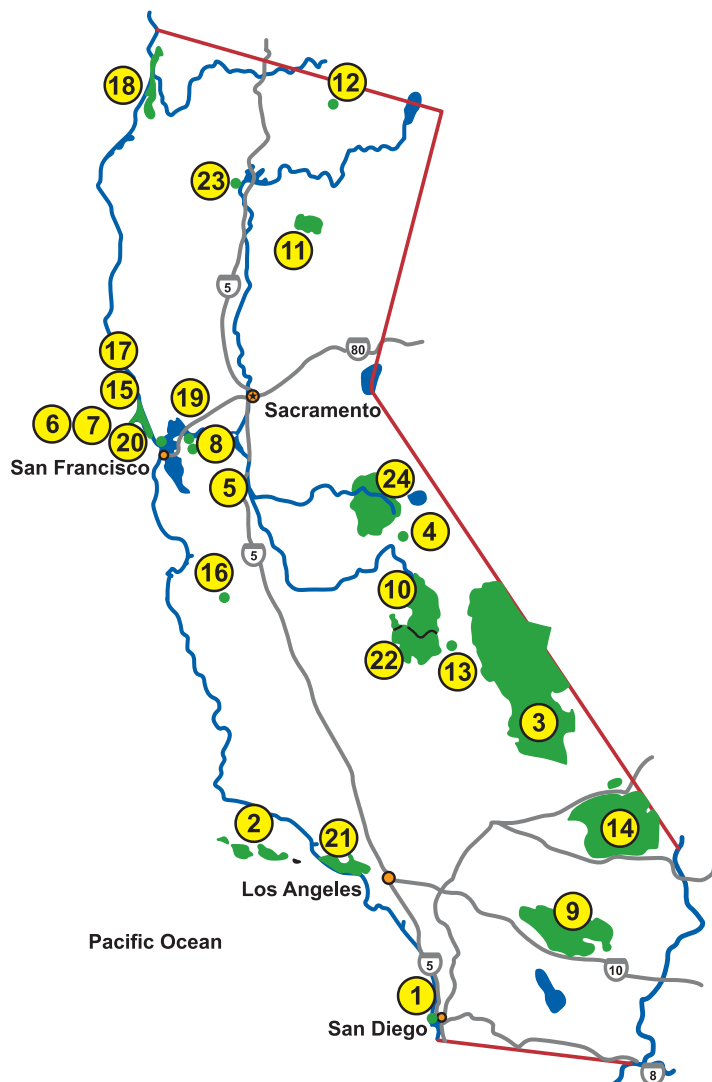
